We knew going into this project that it was nearing the end of the rainy season in the area of Kenya where the city of Kisumu is located – right on the east shore of Lake Victoria. But, in spite of the threat of rain every day, we still believed that God would have us do the project in and around that city. So we made plans to do it and asked all of you to pray for dry weather. Well, the end of the story is that in the two weeks we were there, we completed 62 meetings and did not lose a single one to rain. It rained close by on a few occasions, but it did not rain on our meetings, which were mostly open-air. By the close of the project 31,060 people had prayed to receive Christ.

Sheila and I left on Sunday, May 24 and arrived in Kisumu on Wednesday 27th. The first two meetings were held that afternoon, an open-air market meeting and a film show. 550 people came to Jesus that first day. Every day after that was filled with various kinds of evangelistic meetings and every time the Gospel was preached people were saved. In all we preached in 27 open-air markets, 22 high schools and 13 film shows.
