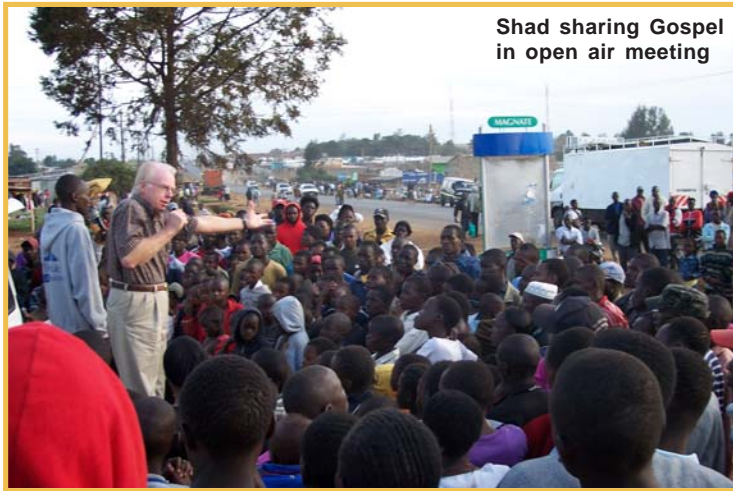

As you know from reading part one of this report (mailed Sept. 18), this project began with the annual GFE International Women's Conference, which was attended by over 600 women from all over western Kenya as well as Tanzania and Uganda. Then it was followed by 9 days of intense "we go to them" field evangelism. Forty meetings were conducted in open-air markets, slums and evening film shows. By the close of the project 27,686 people had prayed to receive Christ. This was the 41st campaign we have conducted in Kenya and it went in the books as another fantastic opportunity to see people come to Jesus.

For the past 32 years we have been going on these campaigns and then coming back and trying to communicate to our friends at home what all goes on out there. I am sure that after so long a time, it may start to sound like the same old same old. And in a sense it is. We go, we preach to the masses, we see thousands saved, then we come
