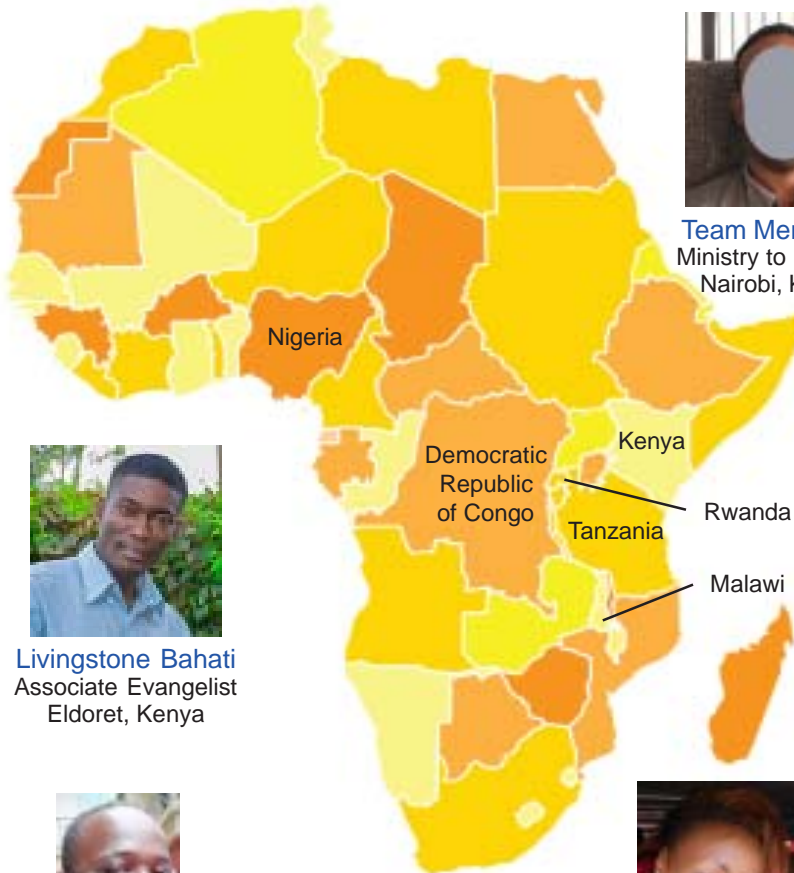

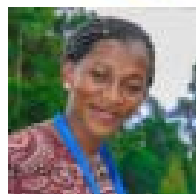

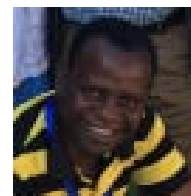

## **VISION 2020 - GOSPEL STORM STILL RISING**

In the days ahead the pandemic will subside, and in its aftermath there will be left a global population that is more keenly aware of its need for the hope and security that only God can provide. A window of opportunity will be opened for aggressive evangelism, but it will not last very long. It is human nature to quickly forget, so we must be ready to take full advantage while we can. ## **EXPANSION PROJECT COMPLETE AND READY FOR ACTION**

Over the past few weeks we have relocated ten team members to ten new fields in Kenya, Rwanda, and Tanzania. When we made the decision to expand the geographical outreach of the ministry, we did not see the pandemic coming, but God did! Surveys have been completed, teams have been formed, and plans are in place to hit these new areas with full force once the ban is lifted. The teams will be preaching in open-air venues, evening film shows, and schools once they resume session. They will also be conducting crash course field evangelism classes for churches that are now eager to learn and ready to reach out.

## **SOME TOOLS STILL NEEDED**

The teams are in place, but there are some things still needed – mainly vehicles and equipment. Five of the teams have been outfitted with a vehicle and a full set of equipment. But, there are still five remaining that need both. With the ban lifted and funding in hand, these things can be provided quickly. So, dear friends, please pray that God will provide these tools for evangelism as soon as possible so there will be no delay in getting the Gospel out to people who are eager to hear. Please pray also for the finances of the ministry in general. We are living through some challenging economic times, and we need to see the continued supernatural intervention of God. He is faithful, and He answers the prayers of His people.

## **2020 FIRST QUARTER – OVER 600,000 RESPOND TO THE GOSPEL**

In spite of the current global health crisis, God has still blessed with a tremendous harvest of souls in the first 90 days of the year. We began with a record-breaking campaign in Mwanza, Tanzania with over 300,000 people praying to receive Jesus. But, in addition, the teams in Congo, Kenya, Nigeria, Malawi, and Tanzania recorded another 331,000, for a total of 638,000 people saying yes to Jesus. Also, hundreds of people received training in field evangelism. And, while all that was going on, we relocated ten team members and their families to new fields. So, it was quite a first quarter, for which we give all praise and glory to God! And, we give thanks to YOU, our beloved friends, for listening to God and helping make it happen!

## **A MUCH BIGGER PANDEMIC**

The Corona virus is undeniably a serious threat to the population of the earth. But, there is an even more serious threat that has been around for a lot longer.
