

EVANGELISM EXPLOSION

250,000 PEOPLE PRAYED TO RECEIVE CHRIST IN 60 DAYS



There is literally SO much ministry going on right now in the field that it is not possible in the space of a newsletter to tell it all! In the first 60 days of the year the teams confronted an average of **5400** people per day with the Gospel of Jesus Christ! Out of those who heard the message of salvation, 250,000 responded by publicly professing Jesus as their Lord and Savior. As always, they are using the simple “we go to them” approach. I am more convinced than ever before that there is no better way to reach people with the Gospel than to just go where they are. Don’t require them to come to a meeting, but take the meeting to them.



In Nigeria, Jonah Obina is doing just that, leading a team of 30 people who are reaching out to that west African country every day. They are seeing thousands come to Christ every week. He is also training hundreds of people in how to evangelize on their own. In the Congo, Oyelo Ulimwengu and evangelist Baraka have seen over 35,000 people come to Jesus in the first two months of 2018. In Tanzania, Ibrahim Mbata and Alex Mbata are seeing thousands of people respond in open-air markets and other public venues. Evangelist Daniel Khatera and his team are reaching hundreds of people daily in Kisii, Kenya. The same is true for Alfred Agasa in the city of Nakuru. In the Eldoret region Patrick Asava and a team there are proclaiming the Good News to thousands weekly in schools, markets, and film shows. Wilfred Andabwa is reaching thousands in the congested city of Nairobi. Gibson Kachaje, and fellow evangelists Lauden Banda and Wales Banda, are also seeing thousands of lives changed in Malawi, Central Africa and neighboring Mozambique.



Every month these men, along with dozens of other team members, are faithfully taking the message of hope to the multitudes. And, God is honoring their efforts and His Word with a great harvest of souls. Some of these names mentioned may not sound familiar, but they are quite well known in heaven. In my opinion, they are unsung heroes. They work tirelessly and faithfully, and the only thing they ever ask for is some money to put gas in the generator or fix a piece of broken equipment. It is an honor to work along side them in the cause that counts.



It is also an honor to be associated with the faithful men and women here in America that God has raised up to be a prayer and support team for this ministry. Again, I will say loudly, this is a TEAM effort. Yes, there is a LOT going on in the field, but it is happening because God has formed a TEAM of people across the world who work together, and believe together, and expect together to see God perform His wonders. And, to ALL of you, I say THANK YOU!!



I also ask you all to continue to pray that God will provide for this work. As I shared last time, the ministry is growing and expanding. We need God’s resources now more than ever. The harvest is not diminishing. It is growing, and we must grow with it. We will be moving into other areas and more countries in the near future, and we need a lot of help to do it. But, we MUST do it. The harvest demands it. So, let’s continue to believe and receive from God as WE GO TO THEM.

Please pray that God will put His hedge of protection around our many team members and keep them healthy and safe. They are under constant attack from the devil as they serve on the front line for the Gospel of Christ. They are strong in faith and deeply committed, but they are human, and they need your prayers. Their families need your prayers, because they also are vulnerable to the attacks of the enemy.

Finally, I ask you to pray that God will continue to open new doors to SWEA/GFE. We are in the process of investigating new areas into which to take the "we go to them" approach. I believe we will be expanding into some of them in the near future.

To date, SWEA/GFE has reached 27 million people with the Gospel and is currently reaching well over 5000 per day. First, we say thank You God, and glory to Your Name! Second, we say THANK YOU to all of you, our beloved friends, for all you do to help keep this going. It has been over 40 years now. I don't know how much further we have to go, but I DO know that ever how far it is, we will do it together for the glory of God.
